

## Changes to RRS, NoR and Sailing Instructions

### **No.1: Correction of anomaly in RRS Rule 60.4 (a) (2)**

Paragraph 2 is changed as follows:

(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 **and** is from a boat that was not involved in and did not see the incident, or

*The changed word is shown in red.*

### **No.2: Clarification of the procedure for initiating a protest or request for redress.**

SI 13.2 is replaced as follows:

**13.2 Hearing Request Forms** are available from the online notice board or on request from the sailing committee. If it is not practicable to submit a protest form at RDYC within the time limit, the initiation of a protest or request for redress may be made on the RDYC Racing WhatsApp group, within the time limit. As a minimum, the incident must be described and protestor and protestee identified or the reason for requesting redress given. This does not exonerate a boat from on the water actions, where applicable, as described in RRS 60.2.
